



SEXUAL HARASSMENT is against the law!

It is SEXUAL HARASSMENT if an employment or educational decision is made based upon your response to demands for sexual favors.

It is SEXUAL HARASSMENT if your job or educational environment is sexually offensive, hostile, or intimidating and this unreasonably interferes with your work or student performance.

It is RETALIATION if your job or student status negatively changes because you reported sexual harassment. This is also against the law.
